The first annual **String Harmonic** event will consist of an art exhibit followed by an auction of the artwork to raise money for the nonprofit project, **Hamomi Children's Centre** (www.hamomi.org). The event is designed to celebrate local artists, music, and the guitar as both instrument and work of art. The central theme for the artwork and event is HARMONY: Bringing together art, music, and people no matter where they live and despite cultural differences. String Harmonic aims to bridge the gap between differing cultures through music and art.

Artists selected to exhibit will receive an **acoustic guitar** as the "canvas" for their work. There is no restriction to design so long as the guitar maintains its original form.

HARMONY is defined in many ways: A tuneful sound; the combination of simultaneous musical notes; a pleasing arrangement of parts; correspondence as in 'living in harmony' with others. These ideas should be used to inspire your art. Think of a time in your life when art and music helped you communicate beyond language and cultural barriers or brought together people from different walks of life in a unique way. Draw from your life experiences and tell those stories through your artwork.

We're excited about this project and your involvement and will give you plenty of time to complete your art. But we know how schedules and lifestyles can change and if you're not able to meet our deadlines we'll have to reclaim the guitar before it's complete.
